May 2008 Tasting Notes

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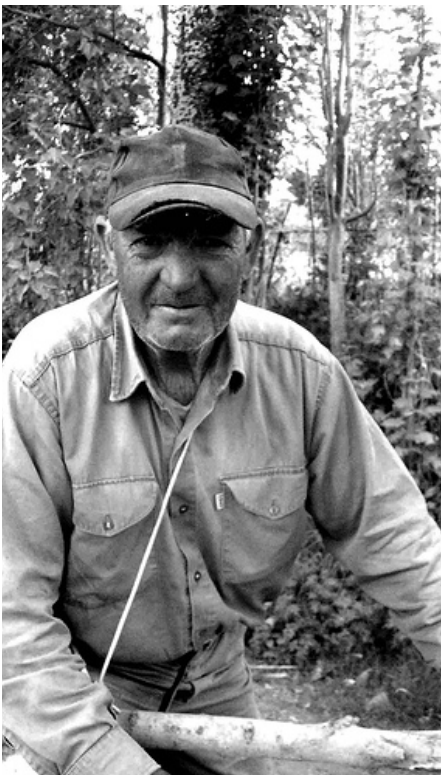
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Hello to all my Trust Carolyn Club members,
