Tasting Notes

This is a Cabernet Franc base wine at 33% along with 17% Petite Sirah, 16% Zinfandel and 11% Cabernet and 11% Merlot.

Fruit forward of dark fruits and layers of taint and structure making this a very balanced wine and a great food wine.

Perfect with fatty foods like rib-eye steak.

Layers of new oak add to the structure of this wine. Aged 36 months in 50% new French and 50% new American oak .at 13.9% Alc. It's a drink now or save for years. Only 100 cases produced
