§ Harvest dates: October 16, 2012

§ Single Vineyard Designate: The Handal-Denier Vineyard, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County

§ In the Cellar: Fermentation in open top tanks with manual punch down 2 - 4 times a day

§ Length of fermentations: 3 day cold soak followed by 5-day active fermentation.

§ Oak Regimen: Aged in 2-year-old French oak barrels for 19 months.

§ Bottled Date: May 2, 2014 Unfined with a light filtration

§ Alcohol: 14.4%

§ pH: 3.65

§ Residual Sugar: Less than 0.1%

§ Varietals: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon; 10% Petite Sirah; 5% Merlot

§ Dry Creek Valley Terroir: Soils of rocky, medium clay.

Tasting notes:

Cedar, black current, blackberry jam; elements of tobacco and leather; fruit and herb flavors intertwine in a lively arabesque, neither dominates, neither subsides - perhaps a waltz, or, maybe a tango?... full in the mouth, satisfyingly complex with a rich finish.

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
