Hello again Locals Choice Club members,


Is it time for a BBQ? I believe it is, and a good barbecue always needs a yummy wine to pair with it. This is the thinking that drove my selections for you this quarter so fire up the grill and cook up some great food because its summertime! Here is a little BBQ Haiku that I like to get you in the mood.

Wrist knows first as warm sauce slides past,
then mouth confirms, great barbecue.

Are any of you good at writing Haiku? Send me a summertime Haiku and there just might be a little prize in it for you...

Those of you that live nearby may have had the chance to taste the Handal Denier wines which have become almost universally popular here at Locals. Relatively new to the Locals lineup, your first perfect barbecue pairing wine is the just released 2014 Handel Denier Zinfandel. This Silver Medal winner from the 2017 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition has a clear red velvety color and jumps out of the glass full of rich ripe fruit. We tried it with some new club members in the tasting room earlier this month and all agreed that the nose alone makes you want to take a sip immediately. I like that in a wine! The wine has a wonderful strawberry note that persists on after you taste the finish of caramel and brown sugar. If you read through to the end of this note you will find a link for a recipe specially selected by owner and winemaker Dick Handal to pair nicely with this wine.

Next up is the 2012 William Gordon Petite Sirah comes from the Alexander Valley, literally a stones throw from the tasting room. The first thing that always strikes me is this wines deep rich almost opaque color. This one will turn your teeth purple for sure. This wine fills the mouth with opulent fruit like ripe blackberries and blueberries with a surprise



finish of soft tannins especially for such a big wine. What I really love is how the taste lingers on and on. Click the recipe link below for a great pairing idea for this beauty.

For those of you who selected a pink or white wine get ready to enjoy the most recent release of the Bedarra Beachfront and the Pendleton Rose both of which will also work nicely with our lighter BBQ dishes, veggies and fish.
