Hello to all my Trust Carolyn Club Members,

Recently I looked back over the 16 years plus years that my little labor of love has been in business and saw how many of you have been members of my club for a long long time. I want to thank you all for your support, which has been especially important during our local fire crisis. While the sweet little hamlet of Geyserville escaped unscathed, the burned hillsides all around us here are a reminder of how lucky we were.

Many of you have asked how the 2017 vintage fared. The warm weather in late August and early September combined with heat spikes led to a quickened harvest resulting in 90 percent of the grapes being harvested prior to the fires. The remaining grapes on the vines were mostly the tough-skinned and late-ripening Cabernet Sauvignon, which vintners believe can withstand smoke in the short-term. This is all good news as wine makes up such a large part of our local economy. As Sonoma County works to recover we are back to business as usual at Locals...and happily picking out some of our favorite wines to send you.

This collection will have a little something for everyone with all kinds of varietals represented. Some are excellent food wines and others will be perfect for that after work glass. There are some single varietals as well as several of my favorite blends. Both the 2014 Praxis Merlot and the 2010 William Gordon Cabernet are recent Double Gold Medal winners.
