This wine opens up with a signature of black currant and dark aromatics, dark ruby color with full bodied and balanced with rich tannins and balanced acid. Aged in 100% new french oak for 40 months. Picked next to Silver Oak with same fruit being also picked for Silver Oak Alexander Valley.

Added with 25% of a field blend of Estate Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot
