Hello again Total Locals Club members,

Summer is in full swing here in Geyserville. Warm sunny days, sultry evenings and grapes growing like crazy all around us in the vineyards. We have been swimming in the Russian River most evenings with Molly, accompanied by some nice chilled wines. Recently we took the Treasure Hunter "Spring Fling" Vermentino along and its light crisp flavor was excellent. This is an uncomplicated summery wine that is perfect for by the pool and the screw top makes it super easy access. After a dip its time for a backyard BBQ and we have kept all of this in mind when selecting wines for you this quarter. Those of you in the three red and three white club will be enjoying the Vermantino soon.

The Denier Handal - Family Selection Syrah blend was the wine we enjoyed alongside a rack of ribs recently and the pairing was superb. Its strong earthy and savory notes were perfect. The wine is also an ideal companion to Mexican food: tacos, nachos, burritos, and chili all go very well with this one, as does the William Gordon - Rink Vineyard Zinfandel. A perennial tasting room favorite; the only problem with this wine is that Bill Pesonan never makes enough of it!

This quarter there is also a special treat for you. The Munselle Wasson Ranch Cabernet Sauvignon does not get into the club very often. It's a special wine, made in limited quantities that we don't open every day in the tasting room. It's a luscious mouthful. Big, deep and dark with a gorgeous finish.

All the other wines in this shipment are also current favorites. We have to taste a lot of wine to make these selections...but someone has to do it, right :)?

As always, be sure to mark your calendar and use your one dollar shipping benefit on a minimum of one case and a maximum of 3 cases from Monday September 9th through September 13th, 2019. Your 45 day discount runs through September 13th, 2019. The dollar shipping benefit is for new orders only and excludes Alaska, Canada and Hawaii. If you use these benefits and would like to store your wines for a later ship date we would be happy to do so.
