Vineyard & Flavor

From the heart of the Russian River Valley Pinot Noir clonal selections 667, 777, 115 and Pommard provide the foundation for this Rose. Nick Leras, "Nick's Block" has farmed this piece of land for two generations and is a rare farmer that understands Pinot should only see French Oak barrels to maintain its grace and elegance.

Winemaking

The vineyard was hand-picked in the chill of dawn delivering cold fruit to the winery. De-stemmed with open rollers on the crusher to allow the berries to pass through for fermentation. The Pinot Noir wine is racked off the skins within hours and fermented in a small temperature controlled tank to maintain a long cool fermentation. All clones are fermented together using Assmanshausen yeast. Following fermentation it is racked to neutral French Oak until bottling.
