Harvest date: October 18, 2010

Fermentation: 7 day cold soak
Inoculated with D254 yeast
Twice daily manual punchdowns
7-12 day fermentation
Transferred to barrels
100% Malolactic conversion

Ageing: 36 months in 100% two to four year old French barrels

53 cases bottled: June 1, 2012 – unfined

Residual Sugar: 0.00 g/100 ml

Bottle aged for 36 months, our 2010 Cab represents the Terrior of Alexander Valley. The aromas of dark current and black cherry balance against a smooth finish. Layered with ripe tannin, its richness lingers well past the last sip.
