TASTING NOTES:

Beautiful deep garnet red color. Nose bursting full of spice, red summer raspberries and hints of white pepper and cedar cigar box. On the palate this zinfandel brings it all together with ripe red fruit, cinnamon spice and balanced subtle tannins and food friendly acidity. The finish is long with lingering notes of cherries & raspberries and cinnamon spice. This Zin rocks!!!
