November 2020 Tasting Notes

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Hello to all my Trust Carolyn Club members,

I can say with certainty that I didn't expect to be writing to you six months later while still wearing a mask in a closed tasting room. I sincerely hope that this great shipment of wine finds you healthy and hanging in there as best you can. My wine consumption has been slightly on the increase. I've heard the same from many of my friends and acquaintances. A yummy glass of wine can certainly be a stress reducer and is always a nice accompaniment to a delicious home-cooked meal; home cooking seems to be really on the rise as well these days.

This selection of wines includes a little something for every palate. Selected from my current tasting room favorites, I'm happy I can share them with you. The difficult harvest is behind us and the holiday season is fast approaching and, while our holiday gatherings are likely to look a bit different this year, there's always room for wine. I'm confident that the selections I've picked for you will add a festive and enjoyable touch to everything from being with family around the Thanksgiving table to decorating for the season. The spirit of the holiday season is what makes it so special and opening a delicious bottle of wine can only serve to enhance that spirit!

This club shipment also introduces you to our most recent winery addition, Dot Wine. We're so excited to welcome Lise and Shawn and their beautiful wines. Included here is their lovely 2019 Chardonnay. This un-oaked wine explodes with tropical pineapple and floral Meyer lemon. It was fermented in a concrete egg which enhances the aromatics of the wine and creates a lovely creaminess. Also included is the 2017 Dot Lolita Vineyard Pinot Noir which hails from the Russian River and grown on a hillside; it offers rose petal and dried cranberry aromas, fine tannins, and well-balanced oak. Winery founder Lise Asimont has spent two decades in the wine industry. She has a passion for viticulture and growing beautiful wines in vineyards using sustainable and regenerative practices.

Also included is the A. Toraño El Bobo Grenache. This wine recently received 92 points from Wine Enthusiast and is described by them as follows: "This lovely vineyard-designate tastes of baked blackberry dusted in cinnamon and nutmeg. Soft supple tannins and well-integrated oak allow the rich, dense fruit to speak loudest with a lasting note of fresh strawberry." Let's see if you agree!

The window is early this year and, if you place your reorders on the early side of the week, you'll likely receive your wines in time for the holidays. A wine club membership makes a great gift as well.

The maximum order for dollar shipping is three cases per club member and the minimum order is one case. The dollar shipping benefit is for new orders only and excludes Alaska, Canada, and Hawaii. Your 45-day discount on follow up runs until January 21st, 2021.

Please note that for those of you in our TLC club your wine selections may differ slightly from those listed based on your stated palate preferences.
