

2014 A. Torano Salome Petite Sirah

The 2014 Salome Petite Sirah has certainly lived up to its name. Salome was a temptress, as is this dark, brooding beauty. From the time you open it, it starts displaying its layers of flavor. It starts out with a mouthful of dark fruit, slowly opening up and exhibiting leather, espresso, cassis as well as mineral notes.

Decanting this wine for an hour is strongly suggested to fully appreciate the complexity of this wine. The aromas will continue to evolve and delight you, its tannins and structure assure you of a long lasting finish.

This year's vintage at Landy Vineyard was beautiful ripe fruit, it was aged in 65% new French oak for 16 months. It is bottled unfiltered and has the structure and tannins to age well for years. It is drinking well now.
