2019 Syrah Canihan Vineyard



Winemaker Notes:

Made in the Côte-Rôtie style of the northern Rhone wine region in France, this wine is a co-ferment of Syrah with 2% Viognier. Grapes were hand harvested the night of October 11, 2019. Syrah and Viognier were fermented together with a small amount (5%) of whole clusters. After a 10 day fermentation, the wine was pressed at 0.5 brix to manage tannin levels. After aging for 15 months in 25% 1 year-old French oak, 25% 2 year-old French oak and 50% neutral French oak, the wine was bottled in March of 2021.

Tasting Notes:

Beautiful violet color; aromas of blueberry and cassis; notes of black currant and strawberry. Great acid and a long finish.
