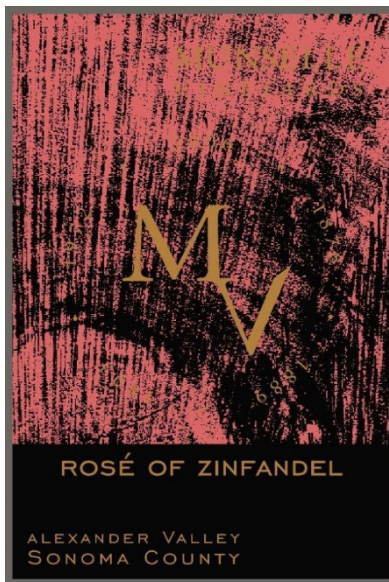

2020 ROSÉ OF ZINFANDEL



APPELLATION: Alexander Valley

VARIETAL COMPOSITION: 100% Zinfandel

HARVEST DATE: September 5, 2020

ALCOHOL: 13.1%

BOTTLING DATE: January 2021

PRODUCTION: 125 cases

2020 had lots of twists and turns, and harvest was no exception. Although we had always talked about adding a rosé to our varietal lineup, the Walbridge Fire in August of 2020 gave us the push we needed. Making a rosé from our Zinfandel grapes, reduced the risk of smoke taint by picking the fruit earlier and decreasing the time the grape skins were in contact with the juice in fermentation.

From such a trying year, has come one of our new favorite summer wines. This dry rosé is bright and refreshing with notes of pomegranate and melon. Enjoy chilled with an afternoon picnic or on a warm summer evening.
