### Vineyard & Flavor

This sustainable vineyard farmed by Liz & Markus Bokisch's Lodi Garnacha Blanca is the varietal for the 2018 Struttin' White. A Spanish varietal, Garnacha makes for a full-bodied white wine with rich flavors of pear, baked apple and subtle notes of honey suckle.

### Winemaking

Harvest: September 10, 2018

Bottled: February 13, 2019

Cases: 124

Fermentation is completed with a Spanish Yeast called M2 in a very cool Stainless Steel tank to preserve the wonderful aromas of Grenache grapes. After the long cool fermentation is complete the wine was racked and chilled stopping the Malo-Lactic or secondary fermentation in order to keep the natural acidity.
