Vineyard: This three acre vineyard is located in the Alexander Valley near Asit. The hilltop location is next to Pesonen Vineyards, belongs to Mark Perry and Melanie Peña, called Viñas de las Peñas or Vineyard of the Rocks. It produces wonderful Petite Sirah full of blueberries, spice and mineral. The soil is chalky, full of rock and well drained. The vineyard is meticulously maintained by William Gordon Winery to ensure quality crop production.

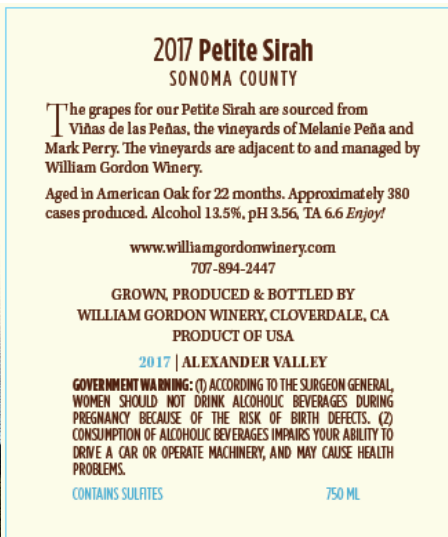
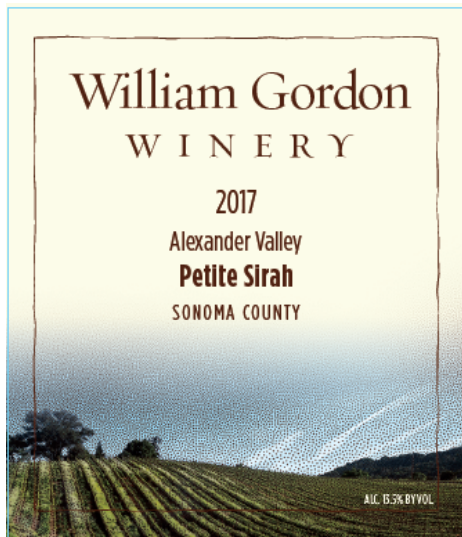

Tasting Notes Color, dark opaque aubergine. Nose, pops with cocoa, cherry cola and soft saddle leather. Palate offers cedar, cherry, plum and spice. Tannins are medium to soft with balanced acidity. Finish is long and smooth with a hint of sweet sage and fig.
