§ Residual Sugar: Less than 0.1%

§ Varietals: Sagrantino

§ Bottled: July 23, 2019

On the nose one may find aromas of caramel, toffee, dried fig and dried cherry that evolve on the palate into flavors of red cherry/strawberry fruit, burnt brown sugar and chewy chalky tannins that persist on the palate, showing this varietal's characteristic balance between opulence and austerity. Our 2017 Sagrantino is dry and rich in the mouth, elegant, tannic, tangy and fruity making it a great food wine, pairing well with prosciutto, sausage, pastas, biscotti and sweet pastries. Salute!
