Winemaker Notes:

Grapes were harvested during the early morning hours of September 4 before being hand sorted and fermented over 11 days. Once pressed, the wine was aged in one-year-old and two-year-old and neutral French oak for 18 months.

Tasting:

Opulent Pinot Noir with notes of dark cherry and strawberry, great structure and finish. Pairs well with poultry, mushroom dishes and all things pork.
