Vineyard & Flavor

This Dry Creek vineyard lies in a beautiful hillside of 100-year-old vines. Full rich smooth aromas with enough backbone to deliver a long smokey finish of blackberry stone fruit. An old Italian farmer once said, "God created Dry Creek Valley so man could plant Old Vine Zin!" This is full bodied Dry Creek OVZ with elegance!

Winemaking

Harvest: September 17, 2017

Bottled: February 14, 2019

Cases: 198

The fruit was gently de-stemmed and tank fermented with traditional twice daily pump overs taming the tannins with splashing during fermentation. RP-15 Yeast produced a very clean fermentation retaining the integrity of the fruit with a combination of American and French Oak Barrel aging to follow. Proper balance with the quantity of new oak complimenting the fruit while not overpowering it. The result a beautiful example of Old Vine Zinfandel in a rich yet polished style.

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
