2021 Syrah Canihan Vineyard



Winemaker Notes:

Made in the Côte-Rôtie style of the northern Rhone wine region in France, this wine is a co-ferment of Syrah with 6% Viognier. Grapes were hand harvested the night of October 10, 2021. Syrah and Viognier were fermented together with a small amount (15%) of whole clusters. After a 10-day fermentation, the wine was pressed at 0.5 brix to manage tannin levels. After aging for 15 months in 50% two-year-old and 50% neutral french oak, the wine was bottled in March of 2023.

Tasting Notes:

Stunning violet color, floral aromas, notes of black currant, strawberry and blueberry.
