2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Asti Ridge Vineyard

Winemaker Notes:

Asti Ridge Vineyard was one of the last vineyards planted by legendary vineyard manager Ulises Valdez Sr. Planted in 2017 we were fortunate enough to be the first to harvest fruit from this amazing place high in the hills of Cloverdale in the Alexander Valley AVA. The grapes were harvested in the early morning of September 11, 2021. Fermentation was complete after 11 days and moved to barrel where it underwent malolactic fermentation. Once completed the wine was racked to 1-year old and neutral french oak barrels where it aged for 18 months.

Classic Alexander Valley Cabernet with notes of black cherry, cassis and plum.
