Vineyard & Flavor

Albon clone Grenache was planted in 2013 providing low yields and premium fruit qualities. Mocha, deep ripe fruit and exhibited. Syrah was planted in 10% of the vineyard to provide brighter aromas and color to the blend. Together they deliver an enriching experience with backbone of balanced tannin.

Winemaking

De-stemmed fruit placed in open top stainless-steel fermenters with temperature control. Twice daily punch downs with RP-15 yeasts provides a cool fermentation integrating the tannins for structure.

French barrels, 20% new, to subtly incorporate oak without over doing it. The remainder of the barrels are 2-6 years old, thus imparting very little if any oak aromas but highly important, providing barrel aging.
